

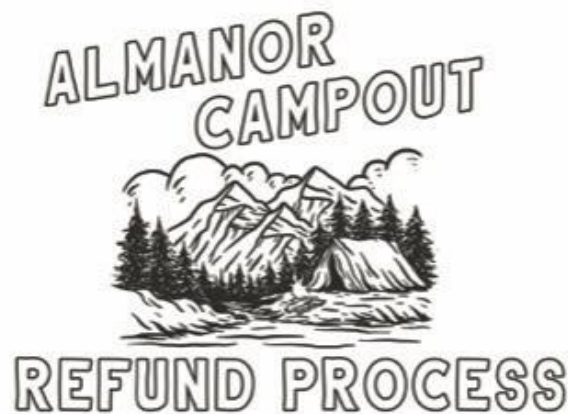

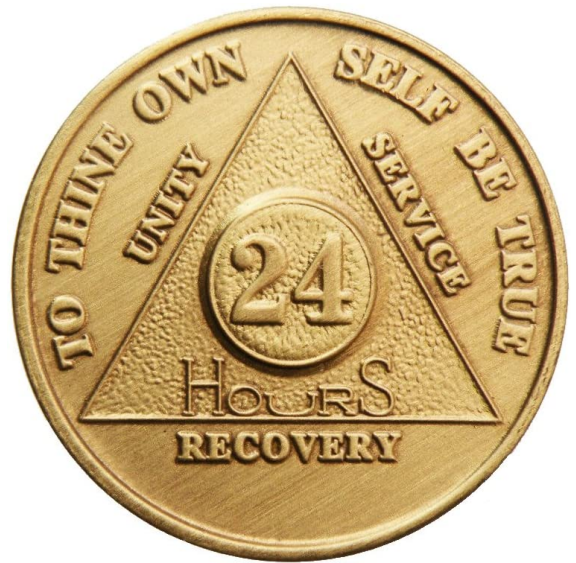
A DECLARATION OF UNITY
