From the Desk of the DCM:
(District Committee Member)

November is typically the time for elections and with elections comes the time for rotation. This can be especially hard if you enjoy what you are doing... which I find is true for myself many a time.

The following words are from Appendix E of the Service Manual and are taken from The AA Group (pamphlet):

"Traditionally, rotation ensures that group tasks, like nearly everything else in A.A., are passed around for all to share. Many groups have alternates to each trusted servant who can step into the service positions if needed. To step out of an A.A. office you love can be hard. If you have been doing a good job, if you honestly don't see anyone else around willing, qualified, or with the time to do it, and if your friends agree, it's especially tough. But it can be a real step forward in growth—a step into the humility that is, for some people, the spiritual essence of anonymity. Among other things, anonymity in the Fellowship means that we forgo personal prestige for any A.A. work we do to help alcoholics. And in the spirit of Tradition Twelve it ever reminds us 'to place principles before personalities'."
