
ABOUT THE TWELVE CONCEPTS

The Twelve Concepts for World Service were written by A.A.'s co-founder Bill W. and were adopted by the General Service Conference of Alcoholics Anonymous in 1962. The Concepts are an interpretation of A.A.'s world service structure as it emerged through A.A.'s early history and experience. While the ideas represented by the Concepts will be familiar to most A.A.s, many members have expressed appreciation for the simplified language and clear images of the pamphlet "Twelve Concepts Illustrated" (Item P-8).

ABOUT THE VIDEO

In this "animated short," based on the illustrated pamphlet, we see our Twelve Concepts brought to life. We follow along as we see how wide participation in the "inverted triangle" of the A.A. Fellowship enables us all to work together to carry the message of hope and recovery.
